

Frequently Asked Questions

TeamViewer Cyber Robotics Competition

1. Who can participate?

- Kids in grades 4th to 6th in Pinellas and surrounding counties in Florida, US.

2. When is the deadline to register teams?

- You can register teams by March 14th.

3. When is the start of the competition?

- March 24th

4. How many teams can I register?

- You can register a max. of 10 teams. If we have spots left, those can be given on top of the 10 places. Please reach out to us if you have more than 10 teams.

5. How many kids can be in one team?

- Teams must be of 5 participants.

6. How old will the participants be?

- Participants should be from 4th to 6th grade.

7. What is the Teacher's Training about?

- During the session, you will learn all you need about how to use the CoderZ platform.

8. How is the competition structured?

- Weeks 1-2: The platform will be open to team leaders so they can become familiar with it. The team leader can already invite students to the platform. During these weeks, teams will have access to the training materials, which will allow them to solve some basic challenges and gain confidence for the next phase. Teams do not get points during this time.
- Week 3-4: The first missions will be revealed to the teams. Teams will have one week to solve them. They start collecting points from the phase on.
- Week 5: Challenge phase starts! Three challenges with high difficulty levels will be revealed to the teams. They have one week to solve them. Once the week is over, the competition ends. A few days after the end of the competition, results and winners will be announced during the onsite award ceremony together with all participants.

9. If participants have already taken part in the first edition of the TeamViewer Cyber Robotics Competition, can they participate again?

- We highly recommend not taking part in the competition if they have already done so, as the challenges will be the same. Therefore, it would not be interesting to them anymore.

10. Who can I reach if I have a technical issue with the platform?

11. How much effort is required from the team lead?

- We highly recommend checking the platform once a week. It is important to monitor the status of the student's engagement and where they might have been having challenges. However, teams can work independently and try to solve issues together.

12. How much time should participants put into the overall competition?

- CoderZ recommends at least 1 hour per week but participants are welcome to invest as much time as possible.

13. Do students need to be physically together to solve the challenges?

- No, students can solve challenges and missions at home or school. However, it is very important that team leaders encourage students to discuss and share ideas during the competition. For example, discussion strategy before the competition starts and how they are planning to solve mission and challenges.

15. Will there be an award ceremony?

- Yes, we are excited to celebrate all the team's efforts together. Winners will be announced during the event for the first time. There will be an onsite ceremony with all participants, and everybody will take a surprise home.
